

OHMY Co., Ltd. Holds Opening Ceremony to Mark a Major Enhancement to Pasta Production Lines at Atsugi Plant

Tokyo, October 5, 2004 — Today OHMY Co., Ltd. (president: Tetsuya Matsushiro) of Atsugi, Kanagawa Prefecture, the Nippon Flour Mills Group's pasta manufacturing company, held an opening ceremony to mark the completion of construction of a new production line to augment pasta production at the Atsugi Plant. Construction began in May of this year.

The Nippon Flour Mills Group has been engaged in profit structure improvement under the New Nippon Way, a three-year medium-term business plan launched two years ago. In accordance with the plan, to respond to market expansion the Group's pasta operation is working to augment capacity of manufacturing lines, boost production efficiency, and enhance quality.

By constructing the new production lines, OHMY has increased pasta production capacity at the Atsugi Plant by about 30% to 2,650 tons per month. The company will redouble its efforts to provide high-quality products that earn customer trust and deliver satisfaction by means of a reliable quality control system underpinned by state-of-the-art production control systems.
